

Great Pyramid Passages is now available on DVD.

Attention: To use this service your computer must be capable of reading digital DVDs. Furthermore, you need a current version of the free program: Acrobat Reader.

**Great Pyramid Passages** was reprinted in 1976 from three of the major works of the Edgar brothers, John and Morton of Glasgow. The Portland Area Bible Students made two more printings in subsequent years due to the high interest in the Pyramid subject. These included a 1929 discourse by Morton and an appendix with extracts of pyramid measurements and prophetic indicators found in earlier works, as well as an overall scriptural index. Photographs and diagrams were all included using a photo offset process to reproduce the pages and appearance of the original works.

With over 1000 pages, and retaining the original page numbering for each of three books under one cover, this was always rather cumbersome to read in its entirety or for research to find specific points of interest. Various other endeavors developed some digitized files for computer use and access. These have included bringing the text into Microsoft Word format, but with re-flowing the paragraphs and pages. Others captured some of the graphics, while others used OCR scans of the pages, but not all the graphics.

Our most recent project comprehensively digitized every page of the original work so as to:

1. Graphically appear exactly as the original pages,
2. Maintain all page, section, chapter, and plate number references,
3. Make all the text searchable to find any word or phrase throughout,
4. Provide a table of contents and index with jump-to or branching capability,
5. Improved high resolution graphics that allow for detail examination,
6. Enable page and graph selections suitable for printing while maintaining clarity.

This was achieved with a graphical image layer over a searchable text layer. This maintains the exact appearance of original pages, yet provides the ability to also search the entire range of material for text and then turn to any selected page with a single mouse click. Pages can be displayed side by side as with the open book, or as single pages.

All graphics were reviewed to clean flaws from the original printing and replacing a number of the graphics with new high resolution scans from original slides where available. Graphics can be enlarged 400-800% without losing clarity. Images can be rotated for convenient viewing and printing.

Acrobat bookmarks were added to match the table of contents and original page numbers. This provides direct linkage to sections, chapters and major diagrams and images.
